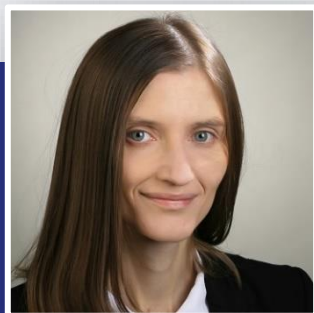

Recognition and enforcement of preventive restructuring proceedings (post Brexit)

The emergence of private preventive restructuring proceedings in Europe as well as Brexit have spurred the discussion on how to recognise and enforce court judgments and restructuring plans across the EU Member States and in third countries. This YANIL Virtual Coffee Break continues our prior discussion and will further the discussion on alternatives for recognition and enforcement.

We will further explore the Brussels I bis Regulation, also, we will discuss the implications of the Gategroup decision and the possible non-applicability of the Lugano Convention for recognition and enforcement of UK decisions in the EU.

At this session, we welcome Prof. **Jessica Schmidt** (Bayreuth Universität) and Dr. **Eugenio Vaccari** (Royal Holloway, University of London) who will share insights from their ongoing research on the challenges raised by the recognition of insolvency and restructuring plans in a cross-border context.
